Mission

The goal of the PREP program is to ensure the health and wellness of Fountain Valley fire personnel as well as educate the community on risk reduction. Some examples of risk reduction activities include Smoke Alarm Outreach, CPR Demonstrations, Drowning Prevention, "Stop the Bleed" Campaigns and Falls Prevention Programs.



Firefighter Health & Wellness

Firefighters suffer more duty-related deaths from cardiovascular diseases than any other identifiable cause. In addition to the physical demands that are performed in hostile and toxic environments, the psychological strain can take its toll as well. Donations to the P.R.E.P program will help provide items such as cardiovascular fitness equipment, fitness classes, mental health seminars, injury prevention classes and other programs to educate and raise firefighter awareness on staying fit for duty as well as self-care activities while off-duty. Firefighters can benefit from classes that focus on work-life balance, stress management and sleep optimization to ensure they maintain the physical and mental health required to do their challenging job.

Supported Programs

SMOKE ALARM OUTREACH

Partnering with local agencies, FVFD will participate in smoke alarm installs, fire safety education and other similar safety community events.

DROWNING PREVENTION

Drownings are a leading cause of injury and death for children ages 1 to 14. Drowning prevention campaigns aim to teach residents the "ABC's" of water safety. Donations can be used to sponsor swim lessons for residents of all ages.

FALL PREVENTION

Falls are the leading cause of fatal and non-fatal injuries for older adults. Our fall prevention program aims to teach adults how to make practical lifestyle adjustments and stay safe around their homes.

"STOP THE BLEED"

This is a national awareness campaign that encourages bystanders to become trained and empowered to help in a bleeding emergency before emergency responders arrive.
