


- Political signs are a traditional means of campaigning and we are pleased to uphold your right to place political signs on private property within the City of Fountain Valley.
- FVMC 21.24.080(k) outlines requirements for temporary non-commercial speech signs, including campaign signs to ensure the sign placement does not effect pedestrian safety, traffic visibility, and safe travel on the City's public right-of-ways.
- Non-residential zones: One sign per each one hundred feet of arterial street frontage. Property owner must calculate the number of signs allowed on their property. No requirement on spacing.
- Residential zones: Four (4) signs per parcel maximum

Requirements for placement of political signs on private property with permission of owner:

- Signs may not exceed three (3) square feet,
- Signs must be freestanding, may not be attached to walls,
- Signs may not exceed six (6) feet in height,
- Signs may not be placed within the fifteen-foot corner cutback area,
- Post signs no more than 60 days prior to election in non-residential zones,
- Remove signs within 10 days after election in non-residential zones,



Height Exception

- Residential properties that back to an arterial street may have freestanding signs not to exceed nine (9) feet in height from adjacent grade.

Regulations on public property FVMC 21.25.040 prohibits any type of signage in the public right-of-way to include streets, sidewalks, medians, street signs, telephone poles, utility poles, traffic signals, flood control channel fencing, City Hall, fire stations, parks, or any other publicly owned property.

Prohibited signs

FVMC 21.24.110 prohibits signs attached to poles or fences, banners on fences, walls, or in landscaping, flags, A-Frame signs, balloons, inflatables, pennants and roof signs are prohibited in the City.
