FOUNTAIN VALLEY POLICE DEPARTMENT AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR PROGRAM

The Fountain Valley Police Department has teamed with Orange Coast Memorial in equipping Fountain Valley Patrol Officers with three Automated External Defibrillator (AED) devices. Fountain Valley Police Officers are oftentimes first responders to many situations involving medical assistance where an AED could assist in lifesaving efforts. Equipping and training Officers in the use of an AED gives Officers a lifesaving tool that meets the need of our community.

On May 19, 2016, Fountain Valley Police personnel met with Orange Coast Memorial personnel to present the new AED devices.
