## **INJURY TRAFFIC COLLISION**

On Thursday, October 25, 2018, at 12:56 PM, the Fountain Valley Police Department received several calls reporting a traffic collision involving a black Mercedes S500 into a building at 16520 Harbor Blvd, Suite G. One victim, a male Hispanic unknown age, was struck inside the building and two additional victims, a 74-year old female Hispanic and a 48-year old male Hispanic, were pinned by the vehicle or debris. Those two victims had to be extracted by Fountain Valley Fire Department personnel. All three victims were transported to area hospitals for non-life threatening injuries. The driver of the Mercedes, a 71-year old female white, remained at the scene and was cooperating with the investigation. She did not sustain any injuries. A preliminary investigation suggested alcohol and/or drugs were not a factor in the collision.
